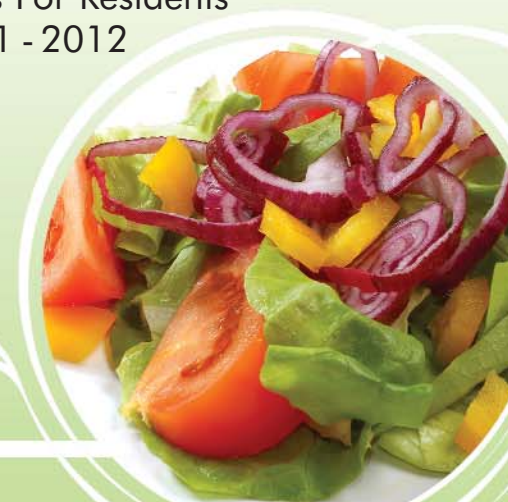

Q. How much do the meal plans cost?

A. Unless otherwise indicated, they are part of the cost for campus residents.

Q. What is the meal plan for commuters?

A. All commuters have a choice of 4 plans. See the Commuter Brochure.

Q. How can I check my meal balance?

A. You can add Cougar Cash and check your meal balance at any register. We also accept credit cards for all purchases and additions to Cougar Cash.

Q. What if I lose my ID Card?

A. CougarNet can replace your ID for a fee. Remember, no ID = no food.

CAMPUS DINING MEAL PLANS

In order to meet your campus dining needs, we have designed the following meal plans for the 2011-2012 academic year. If you need to purchase a meal plan, or if you would like to make a change to the plan you have already selected, simply contact Andrew Pollom in the Office of Residential Life X 3248.

CT Plan (\$100 additional cost per semester)

225 Meals per semester + \$425 in Cougar Cash per semester

Cougar Plan (Default Plan - No additional cost)

200 Meals per semester + \$225 in Cougar Cash per semester

Maroon and Gold Plan (\$200 reduction in cost per semester)

120 Meals per semester + \$275 in Cougar Cash per semester

Please Note: "J" Term plans will be announced at a later date

Applies to ALL Meal Plans

Students may exchange any numbers of meals for \$5 per meal in Cougar Cash. Students may reallocate meals to Cougar Cash until October 7, 2011, for the fall semester, and February 24, 2012, for the spring semester. Students are allowed to utilize an unlimited number of allotted meals at any given meal. Meal exchange is available at each campus food service outlet during all hours of operation. A meal exchange is one of the pre-determined meal replacements. Default Meal Plan is the Cougar Plan

Meals do not carry over from fall semester. No meal equivalency. Cougar Cash may carry over from first semester to second semester, unless opting for a lower plan the second semester. All fall semester Cougar Cash balances are forfeited if changing to a lower plan the second semester.

Student Teaching/Internship Meal Plan

50% allotment of any of the above meal plans. Discount depends on plan selected. All meal plan selections can be changed up to the first day of class each semester. Meal plans must be changed in the Office of Residential Life.

Having trouble selecting a meal plan? Try considering your daily routine... Do you eat three meals a day? Will your class schedule, studying, extracurricular activities and social events interfere with dining? Will you miss dinner due to employment or evening classes?

Anticipating the answers to these and similar questions will help you to select a meal plan that best fits your lifestyle.
